Temporary Opportunities

Student Community Service Program with Carter Church

We are looking to build a team of students over time to engage with in fulfilling their Community Service hours. We see this as a long-term relationship with the school and the students.

We can offer students the chance to participate in fun, diverse, and meaningful projects that have impact on a local, national, and international scale. Students can select among the available projects as they wish - they can choose to focus on one or two projects or experience a wide variety of projects. We can offer students at least 30 – 60 service hours in projects that they can space out as they wish over up to four years. We invite anyone to apply; no religious affiliation is required. Students are welcome to apply at any time from their freshman year through their senior year. Some examples of available programs include:

Helping the Hungry (May 7 and May 21, 2017). There are two activities during May focused on helping the hungry. On May 7, we are sponsoring a group of people who will be doing the Walk for Hunger. And on May 21, we will be sponsoring a Rise Against Hunger event, where a large group will pack 10,000+ meals to be distributed to needy children in school meal programs overseas.

Assisting at Vacation Bible Camp (June 26-30, 2017). Serving as a counselor at our Vacation Bible School, which is an affordable week long summer camp experience for children in Needham.

Helping at our Pumpkin Patch (October 2017). Helping to unload pumpkins from trucks and assisting and welcoming visitors. We purchase the pumpkins from a farm located on a Navajo reservation in New Mexico which provides employment and financial support for the Navajo people. All proceeds after paying for the pumpkins are donated to service and charitable organizations.

Organizing Gifts for Foster Children (December 2017). Helping to organize holiday gifts for foster children being supported by the Massachusetts Department of Family Services.

Supporting our Christmas Tree Recycling Program (January 2017). Helping on trucks which pick up Christmas trees from Needham homes and deliver them to the Town recycling station to be composted. The service is free but donations are accepted. All donations are contributed to charity – in 2016, the donations went to the Needham Community Council and to the Needham Gift of Warmth program. In previous years, the program has supported the global Imagine No Malaria program.

Assisting at our Bread of Life Community Meal Program (Ongoing). Helping to prepare food, serve and clean up at our Bread of Life community meal. This is a free meal which allows those who attend to have fellowship and music during dinner.

Volunteering at service organizations (Ongoing). Joining groups of people to volunteer at Boston area service organizations such as Rosie's Place, the Greater Boston Food Bank, Generic Ministry, and Common Cathedral. The latter two organizations support the homeless in Boston.

We offer scholarships to graduating students based on community service. Students who participate in this program are welcome to apply for these scholarships.

Rise Against Hunger event at Carter Church (May 21, 2017)

Event: On May 21, we are sponsoring a large group who will pack 10,000 or more nutritious meals for the needy through a program with Rise Against Hunger. This organization distributes literally millions of meals each year, primarily to school feeding programs in developing countries. We understand from other groups that have hosted events that it is a great service activity which brings together people of all ages. This activity is available as part of a program of community service activities that students can participate in to obtain 30 or 60 hours of community service.

What Will We Do?: We will do assembly line packaging of dehydrated meals. The meals are comprised of rice, soy, vegetables, and 23 essential vitamins and minerals. We understand that a group of 40-50 or more people can pack 10,000+ meals in two hours.

When: Sunday, March 21 at 12:00 noon.

Where: Carter Church, 800 Highland Ave., Needham

Who: This event is for all ages – including children as young as five, youth, and adults of all ages. There are a variety of different roles in the packing process so that people can be given an appropriate role.
