### Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2020 elections.

Last day to register to vote and change party enrollment for the State Primary:

Saturday, August 22, 2020

Last day to apply for an Absentee or Early Vote Ballot **BY MAIL** before the State Primary:

Wednesday, August 26, 2020 –5 PM

Last Day to apply **IN PERSON** for an Absentee Vote Ballot before the State Primary:

Monday, August 31, 2020 – 12 PM
