





## Housing Search Case Management Services for residents of Natick, Needham, Newton, Wellesley, & Weston

In recognition of the hardship many households are facing in finding affordable housing in the Metro West suburban area, Metro West CD is offering housing search services and, *when funds are available*, financial assistance grants for households that reside in one of the above 5 towns and meet the income criteria. This program is funded through the generosity of the Newton-Wellesley Hospital.

## **Applicants are eligible for:**

- FREE one-on-one Housing Search Counseling sessions
- Up to \$500 for a back-to-work grant
- Up to \$2500 for a housing-related financial assistance grant

## **Eligible Households:**

• Total Household income (at the time of application) cannot exceed the following limits:

## **The Process:**

The Program is being administered by Metro West Collaborative Development for households that live in one of the above municipalities.
