## > Program Focus: Seminars at Needham High School: Teen Dating Violence and Loss

The Teen Dating Violence's survey indicated that 10% of 9<sup>th</sup> graders have been in an abusive relationship; further, 47% responded that they know someone who is in a relationship in which there is violence --- each of these statistics represent a 110% increase as compared to last year. The Loss program continues to be challenging for students and was very well received. Comprehensive evaluations for each will be available in the month ahead.
