• Matters Related to the Hiring of a new Director

After staff members were excused, the Director of Health & Human Services Timothy McDonald led a discussion with the Youth Commission members about the search process for a new Director of Youth & Family Services. Mr. McDonald described the process and the involvement of a broad array of stakeholders over an approximately four month period which included job description review and job posting development, application reviews, first round interviews, and second round interviews. The process involved the participation of Youth & Family Services Division staff members, other Health & Human Services Department staff and managers, managers from other Needham departments, school administrators, the Superintendent, the Town Manager, and Youth Commission members. Feedback about the characteristics needed in a new good Director was sought from an even broader group of stakeholders, and that feedback was gathered by email, through phone calls, and during in-person meetings. The three Youth Commission members who participated in the search process also spoke at length about their involvement and their perspectives on the candidates. The full membership and Mr. McDonald continued to discuss the strengths of the candidates in great detail over more than two hours. The meeting ended without a clear consensus on the strongest candidate to become the new Director.
