Needham Council for Arts and Culture Awards Record Number of Grants and Funding to Support Local Projects

Council Awards 29 Grants \$17,865 in Funding

NEEDHAM – February 5, 2024--The Needham Council for Arts and Culture (NCAC) has awarded 29 grants totaling \$17,865 in artistic and cultural programming that provide public benefit to Needham. This year saw an increase in both funding and applications ranging from theatre productions, musical performances, artist workshops, cultural events, public art, and even a new poet laureate for the Town of Needham. A complete list of recipients is below.

"The Council is excited about the increased interest from applicants this year," said Joni Schockett, Co-Chair of the NCAC. "This is the second year we have received funding from the Town of Needham and it's allowed us to continue to approve more requests from such a diverse group of local artists and organizations. The NCAC is happy to help make these creative ideas a reality."

The NCAC received a significant increase in applications the past few years. Given the rising interest in arts and culture programming in the community, the Town of Needham contributed \$8,300 to the state allocation of the Mass Cultural Council for the second straight year.

"Congratulations to all of this year's grant recipients," said Select Board Chair Marianne Cooley. "It's exciting to be a part of a community that is so passionate about the arts. Projects and performances like those supported by these grants are a key component of making Needham a welcoming, fun, and interesting place to live. The Select Board is pleased to continue supporting the NCAC and arts and culture in Needham."

Decisions about which activities to support are made at the community level by the members of the NCAC, a board of municipally appointed volunteers. Granting priorities included applications that address the needs of underserved or in-need groups and those who elevate the diverse voices and experiences of historically marginalized populations. For 2024, the NCAC has committed to focusing on community and civic engagement projects that connect Needham residents through community events, grantmaking, and public art projects.

The Needham Council for Arts and Culture is part of a network of 329 Local Cultural Councils serving all 351 cities and towns in the Commonwealth. The LCC Program is the largest grassroots cultural funding network in the nation, supporting 7,500 community-based projects in the arts, sciences, and humanities every year. The state legislature provided \$7 million in funds this year to the Mass Cultural Council, a state agency, which then allocates various amounts to each community.
